

Left native fluid in hole. Set cast iron bridge plug at 9500' with 1 sack cement on top of plug. Tested casing with 1000#, no pressure loss. Perforated casing, Wolfcamp zone, 9380-9412'. Acidized perforations with 1000 gallons 15% acid and with 6000 gallons dolofrac. Tested Wolfcamp - no recovery.
