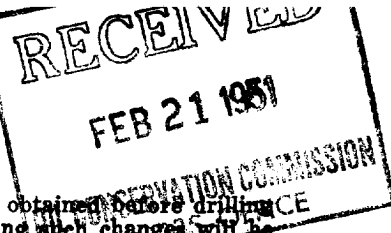

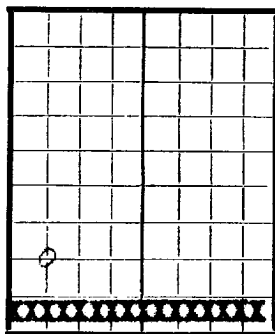

LOCATE WELL CORRECTLY We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: from surface to total depth of approximately 12,500' with rotary tools.

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Bond #1120 (General Casualty Co. of America) in effect.

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 9,150 feet.
