This is supplement to Form C-102, approved by OCC April 29, 1954 on subject well. The work proposed has failed to result in regaining natural flow or top allowable production. Water production from Fonso #1 is coming from communication between perforated intervals behind the casing. It is proposed to plug back to 12520' using hydromite, so that water production can be shut off, and pull tubing and perforate Devonian formation 12315-12426', set Baker production packer at 12440'. Rerun tubing with anchor packer set 12,290'. Acidize new perforations, test and return well to production.
