We are returning for your conditional approval Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, on our State "T" No. 6 Well (located 2310' from the North line and 2310' from the West line of Section 2, T-15-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico) pending final approval by the Commission as the result of a formal hearing.

A request for a hearing in October in order to obtain formal approval to drill at this unorthodox location will be filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission very soon. In the meantime waivers will be obtained from Skelly, Gulf and Shell.
