## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 139 joints & 1 nipple 4637' of 9-5/8" OD 36# 8 RT R-3 N-80 & J-55 SS casing. Set and cemented at 4649' w/2060 sacks El Toro & Longhorn 4% gel and 200 sacks Regular Neat Trinity on bottom. Plug pumped to 4563'. Maximum pressure 900#. Gulf temperature survey in 8 hours found top cement 1522' from rotary bushing.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement from 4563' to 4649', tested cement below casing shoe w/1000# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
