DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 223 joints 9428' of 7" OD 23-26# N-80 & J-55 SS Casing. Set and cemented at 9444' w/675 sacks 45 Gel Trinity slow set cement. Plug at 9358'. Maximum pressure 1500#. Gulf temperature survey in 8 hours found top cement at 6615'.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 7" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement from 9282' to 9400'.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to complete well.
