DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After waiting over 48 hours tested 7" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Started drilling cement at 11,030' at 3:00 PM 21st. and drilled retainer at 11040' and cement to 11,090', cleaned out to 11,125'. Tested perforations in 7" casing at 11,090' w/1750# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Cleaned out and drilled cement to 12,550' Job completed 3:00 AM May 22, 1952.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector preparations were made to complete well.
