ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on December 16, 1993, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Jim Morrow.

NOW, on this <u>28th</u> day of December, 1993 the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Kinlaw Oil Corporation (Kinlaw), seeks to establish a high angle/horizontal directional drilling pilot project in the Denton-Devonian Pool within its Mexico "F" (State) Lease comprising Lots 1 through 4 (N/2 N/2 equivalent) and the SW/4 NE/4 and SW/4 NW/4 of Section 2, Township 15 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Denton-Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) The applicant also seeks the promulgation of special operating rules and procedures for wells within said lease including provisions for administrative authorization for high angle/horizontal wellbores, the formation of oversized and irregular shaped spacing and proration units to accommodate such wellbores and the assignment of special oil allowable or formula for the project area.
