DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 115 joints 4677.80' of 9-5/8" OD 40# & 36# S-95 & J-55 SS casing. Set and cemented at 4690' w/1925 sacks cement, 1800 sacks 4% gel, 125 sacks Neat on bottom. Maximum pressure 1800#. Plug at 4604'. Gulf temperature survey in 10 hours showed top cement at 455' from rotary bushing.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 4604' to 4690'. Tested cement below casing shoe w/500# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
