DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 11 joints 348.18' of 13-3/8" OD 8 RT 48# H-40 R-2 SS casing. Set and cemented at 362.18' w/425 sacks El Toro regular cement. Plug at 337'. Maximum pressure 300#. Cement circulated approximately 25 sacks.

After waiting over 24 hours tested 13-3/8" casing w/800# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug and tested cement below shoe w/300# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
