### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 115 joints 4687' of 9-5/8" OD 36# S-80 & J-55 SS Casing. Set and cemented at 4699' w/1900 sacks, 1750 sacks 4% Gel and 150 sacks Neat cement on bottom. Plug at 4614'. Maximum pressure 1050#. Gulf temperature survey in 8 hours found top cement at 1060'.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 4614' to 4699', tested cement below casing shoe w/800# pressure for 30 minutes, there was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
