DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 311 jts and cut jt (12,685') of 7" speed tite, hydrill H-80 & P-110 23, 26 and 32# 88 casing with 24 scratchers and 14 centralizers from 12,385-12,695' and 6 centralizers from 9650-9180'. Set and cemented at 12,699' with 660 sacks Trinity inferno slow set 4 1/2 Gal cement. Plug at 12,612'. Maximum pressure 3000#. Howee temperature survey after 12 hours showed top of cement at 8362'.

After waiting over 36 hours, tested 7" casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement 12,200-12,675' and tested cement with 1000# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to complete the well.
