DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 114 joints 4666' of 9-5/8" OD 36 & 40# J-55 SS Casing. Set & cemented at 4679' w/3320 sacks cement, 3170 sacks 4% Gel & 150 sacks Neat on bottom. Plug at 4588'. Maximum pressure Cement circulated.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 mins. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 4588' to 4679', tested cement below casing shoe w/800# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
