Dumped 75 gallens pea gravel on top and followed with 44 gallons of Gal Seal. Found top of plug at 9645 feet. Bridge holding OK. Spotted 200 sacks of cement from 9630 feet. Circulated and hole remained full all the way. Pulled tubing free, Checked top of plug at \$993'. (4) Pulled tuking to 4770 feet and spotted 20 sack cement plug.
