Total Depth 4742' Lime. Ran 118 joints of 9-5/8" OD casing, Grade N-80 set @ 4741'. Cemented w/2000 sacks cement, (first 1500 sacks mixed w/4% HOWCO gel and 500 sacks regular cement). Cement came up to 1655'. Cement set 48 hrs. Tested w/1200# pressure for 30 minutes. Test ok.
