Total Depth 9318' Line. Ran 246 joints (159 joints 15.5# XL Grade J-55; and 87 joints 17# Grade N-80 XL) 5-1/2" casing set @ 9316'. Cemented first stage with 100 sacks cement plus 8% gel. Cemented second stage with 1000 sacks cement with 8% gel. First stage plug pumped down @ 1:35 A.M. 8/27/52, cement circulated approximately 10 sacks out. Second stage plug pumped down @ 8:15 A.M. 8/27/52. Will test at approximately 8:15 A.M. 8/30/52.
