DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth 9255' Lins. Ran 287 joints of 5-1/2" casing set @ 9254'. Cemented first stage w/315 sacks slce set cement w/3% gel preceded by 20 bbls. smentox treated water. Pump pressure 500#, final pressure 1400#. Circulated out estimated 75 sacks. Second stage cement w/1327 sacks slce set cement w/3% gel, cement did not circulate. Pump pressure 2500#, final pressure 3700#. Plug pumped down @ 11:00 a. m. 11-22-1953. Found top of cement @ 8582'. Tested casing w/1000# pressure for 30 minutes. Test ok. Preparing to perforate and run tubing.
