Western Company acidized Wolfcamp Formation through casing perforations from 9020' to 9170' with 500 gallons mud acid. Flushed with 37 barrels oil. Maximum tubing pressure 5200#, minimum 5100#. Swabbed 12 hours, recovered flush oil and acid water. Shut in 10 hours, tubing pressure 200#. 4-29-52 Swabbed 14 hours, 65 barrels oil. Shut in 10 hours tubing pressure 240#.
