Drilled well to 4660'. Ran 160 joints, 4647' of 8-5/8" OD casing set at 4657.71'. Cemented with 1725 sacks 8% gel cement followed by 100 sacks 3% gel cement. Pumped plug to 4632'. Cement circulated to surface. Tested casing before and after drilling plug. No pressure loss.
