Ran 146.37' of 1-1/2" 2.75# line pipe & 198 jts, 8097' of 2-3/8" OD 4.7# 8rd thd J-55 tubing "B" condition, 100 jts, 3007', 2-3/8" OD 4.7# 8rd thd N-80 "A" condition. Total 298 jts, 9104', set 9290'. Tubing perfs 9268.47-9289.57 & 9206.28-9247.33. Kobe casing pump 4" x 1-3/4" set 9141.
