**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Western Company acidized Wolfcamp Formation through casing perforations 9415' to 9458' with 1500 gallons 15% regular acid. Flushed with 37 barrels oil. Maximum tubing pressure 4900#, no break. Swabbed 7 hours, recovered flushoil and acid water. Shut in 12 hours, tubing pressure 150#. 4-13-52 Swabbed 10 hours, 5 barrels oil & gas out mud, 30 barrels free oil. Shut in 14 hours, tubing pressure 50#.
