Western Company acidized with 500 gallons 15% Regular acid through perforations 9478' to 9530'. Maximum tubing pressure 4500#, minimum 3000#. Maximum casing pressure 3000#. Formation broke from 4500# back to 3800#. Swabbed 6 hours, recovered flush oil and acid water. Shut in 12 hours, tubing pressure zero. 4-3-52 Swabbed 12 hours, 7 barrels oil and gas cut mud and 6 barrels acid water. Shut in 12 hours, tubing pressure zero.
