Drilled well to 4653'. Ran 197 joints, 4642', 8-5/8" OD casing set at 4652'. Cemented with 1400 sacks 8% gel cement followed by 150 sacks neat. Pumped plug to 4622'. Cement circulated to surface. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug. Test OK.
