FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well is presently perforated in the Mississippian formation from 11,240' to 11,288' & is producing 75 to 80% water and 6 bbls. oil per day. It is proposed to perforate the Wolfcamp from 9280-9300 & 9330-9380 with 4 shots per foot and acidize with 7500 gallons of acid. Two bridging plugs will be set in the casing, one plug at approximately 11,200' and the second plug at 9420'. Each plug will have a plastic cap of 10' to 15' set on top of the plug.
