### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After drilling a 12 $\frac{1}{4}$ " hole to 5000', the intermediate string of 9-5/8" O.D. 43.5# and 36# N-80 and J-55, new casing was cemented at 5000.96' with 3000 sacks of Trinity Inferno bulk cement. After waiting 48 hours for the cement to harden, the casing was tested with 1000# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.
