DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After drilling a 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ " hole to 360', 13-3/8" O.D. 48# H-40 new casing was cemented at 347.63' with 600 sacks Lone Star regular cement. Cement returned to the surface. After waiting 24 hrs for the cement to harden, the casing was tested for 30 minutes with 1000# pressure. There was no drop in the pressure.
