PBTD 12,530' 7-5/8" casing set at 11,865' with 5-1/2" liner set at 12,749' with perforations at 12,330-12,430', and 12,470-12,520'. Recent tests have indicated that the water that is being produced is formation water and is being produced from the bottom perforations from 12,470-12,520'. It is requested that permission be granted to squeeze-cement perforations from 12,470' to 12,520' in an attempt to shut off bottom hole water.
