PRESENT STATUS OF HOLE: Plugged and abandoned by the McAlester Fuel Company on February 20, 1950.

Six drill collars and five joints of 4-1/2" drill pipe were left in hole approximately 30' off bottom.

A Baker Retainer is set at approximately 2000' in 9-5/8" OD casing with a sinker bar and 1000' of 9/16" wire line on top of Retainer.

Cement plugs have been spotted at approximately 11,400', at 4800' and on top of Retainer at 2000'.

8-3/4" hole was drilled from 4805' to 12,015'.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (Continued)

WE PROPOSE TO ENTER THIS HOLE AND REDRILL WELL AS FOLLOWS:

OBJECTIVE: Denton Devonian Pay Zone.

NEW TOTAL DEPTH: 12,800' or Devonian Pay Section if penetrated at a lesser depth.

METHOD OF REDRILLING: We propose to move in a No. 3-A National Machine cable-tool rig, fish out wire line and Baker Retainer, drill cement plugs and clean hole out to approximately 4800'. If this operation proves successful a rotary drilling rig will be moved on location to clean hole up to top of drillpipe junked in hole at approximately 11,650'. It is intended to side-track stuck drillpipe at this point and drill a new hole to objective. It is tentatively proposed to set a string of 7-5/8" OD (special clearance) or 7" OD casing at approximately 11,750' and cement with 1500 sacks of cement in order to shut off lost circulation zone logged from 11,420-620'.

In the event that the above plan cannot be accomplished this well will be properly plugged in a manner approved by the Commission and a Notice of Intention to Drill a New Well will be submitted.
