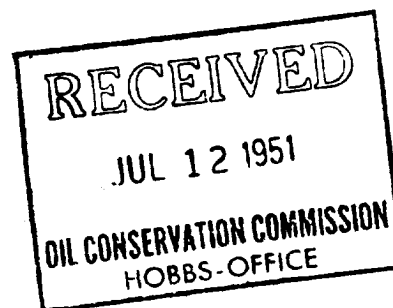

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We plan to acidize this well with 10,000 gallons of acid (1000 gallons of
jel-acid, 9000 gallons of F-29 with M-18) through casing perforations at
11,080-11,100' and 11,130-11,150' on July 5, 1951. Before acidizing the
well has been averaging 280 BOPD on a 1/2" choke with a tubing pressure
of 75 psig.
