DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was acidized with 6000 gallons of acid through casing perforations at 11,080-100; 11,120-50. An oil blanket was used to protect the casing seat. After acidizing the well flowed 35 HOPH on a 1/2" choke with 390 psi tubing pressure.
