DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Plug Back Depth: 5690' - Line

At the time Form C-102 was filed it was intended to produce well from zone 5540-5690', but after two stages of 2000 and 8000 gallons respectively results were unsatisfactory, so it was decided to perforate from 5415-5525' and acidize with an additional 5000 gallons, which was completed 3-13-47. After treatment well swabbed dry. The casing was then perforated 5300-5400' and this zone was treated with 5000 gallons on 3-17-47 and on 12 hour test well swabbed 1 barrel of oil per hour.
