Hole was filled with heavy mud and spotted cement plug of 150 sacks from 6620' (Total Depth) to 5270'. Parted and pulled 3700' of 5-1/2" casing and spotted cement plug of 20 sacks from approximately 3750 to 3050'. (In the top of the parted 5-1/2" casing) Spotted cement plugs: 30 sacks 3400 to 3300'; 30 sacks 3150 to 3050'; 30 sacks 2200 to 2100' (in the bottom of the 8-5/8" casing). Parted and pulled 900' of 8-5/8" casing and spotted cement plug of 50 sacks from 950 to 850' (in the top of the parted 8-5/8" casing). Spotted cement plug of 50 sacks 300 to 250' (in the bottom of the 13-3/8" casing). Customary 4" pipe marker was cemented in the hole with 20 sacks leaving all 13-3/8" casing cemented in the hole. All mud and cement plugs were pumped in through tubing. The above work was completed 12:00 P.M. June 8, 1947.
