NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Amer. Natl. Ins. Co. Well  
No. 1 in SE 1/4 of Sec. 28 of Sec. \_\_\_\_\_, T. 16S, R. 38E,  
N. M. P. M., \_\_\_\_\_ Oil Field, Lea County.  
We plan to commence work on March 6, 1930, 19\_\_\_\_.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

**Dry hole below all know sand formations**

The present condition of the well is as follows:

**Shut down at 5160 feet in hard lime**

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

**Mud from bottom of hole to base of salt  
put dry wooden plug and 15 sacks of cement mud up to top  
of salt put wooden plug and 15 sacks of cement mud to  
surface water put wooden plug and 10 sacks of cement  
mud to top of hole**
