Since completion date production has decreased to 6392 barrels of oil for the month of December, 1949, or an average of 206 barrels in 24 hours. It is our intention to reacidise this well with 4000 gallens of Dowell acid through the perforations from 12560' to 12596' in an attempt to increase production.
