

Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used, and results obtained.

On February 3, 1959, the above well was plugged and abandoned. Cement plugs were set through 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " drill pipe by the displacement method as follows: 3600' -3535' w/20 sx; 2745'-2680' w/20 sx; 2493'-2428' w/20 sx; 1201'-1038' w/50 sx ; 382-317' w/20 sx 10'-surface w/10 sx. Drilling mud with gravity of 10.8 #/gallon was employed in plug ing operations. Surface casing (350.25' of 8 5/8", 24#, J-55.) was left in hole. Pits have been filled, location leveled and cleared. Operations completed on March 14, 1959.
