3915' Total Depth - Lime. Finished drilling 11" hole @ 9:30PM, 4-29-53.  
Ran a total of 101 jts. 8-5/8" OD Casing set @ 3915' w/ 1500 sz. cement. Pumped plug to 3847' @ 9AM, 4-30-53. w/ Max. pressure 800#. Ran Temperature survey - found top of cement outside 8-5/8" Casing @ 1722' of 46.4% fill. After WOC for 2 1/2 hours tested casing w/ 1000# for 1/2 hour - O.K. Drilled cement from 3847' to 3915' and tested casing for 1/2 hour w/ 1000# - O.K. Started drilling formation and 7-7/8" hole @ 7:45PM, 5-1-53.
