DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with plans as outlined in phone conversation with Mr. Frost on Dec. 31, 1949, this well has been abandoned as follows: Hole was drilled and an attempt was made to pull 7" casing landed at 3221'. Pipe was parted and pulled, leaving 3 joints in hole. A 15-cask cement plug was then spotted at 2870' and another 15-cask cement plug at 1800' to 950'. The 8-5/8" casing landed at 876' was then parted and pulled, leaving 3 joints in hole. All of the 10-3/4" casing which was set at 904' was pulled. A 10' plug of cement was placed at the surface, completing plugging.
