DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to a total depth of approximately 4,300'. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 8 5/8" casing to be set at approximately 200' and cemented with 100 sacks, cement to be circulated. 5 1/2" casing to be set at approximately 4300' and cemented with 900 sacks.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

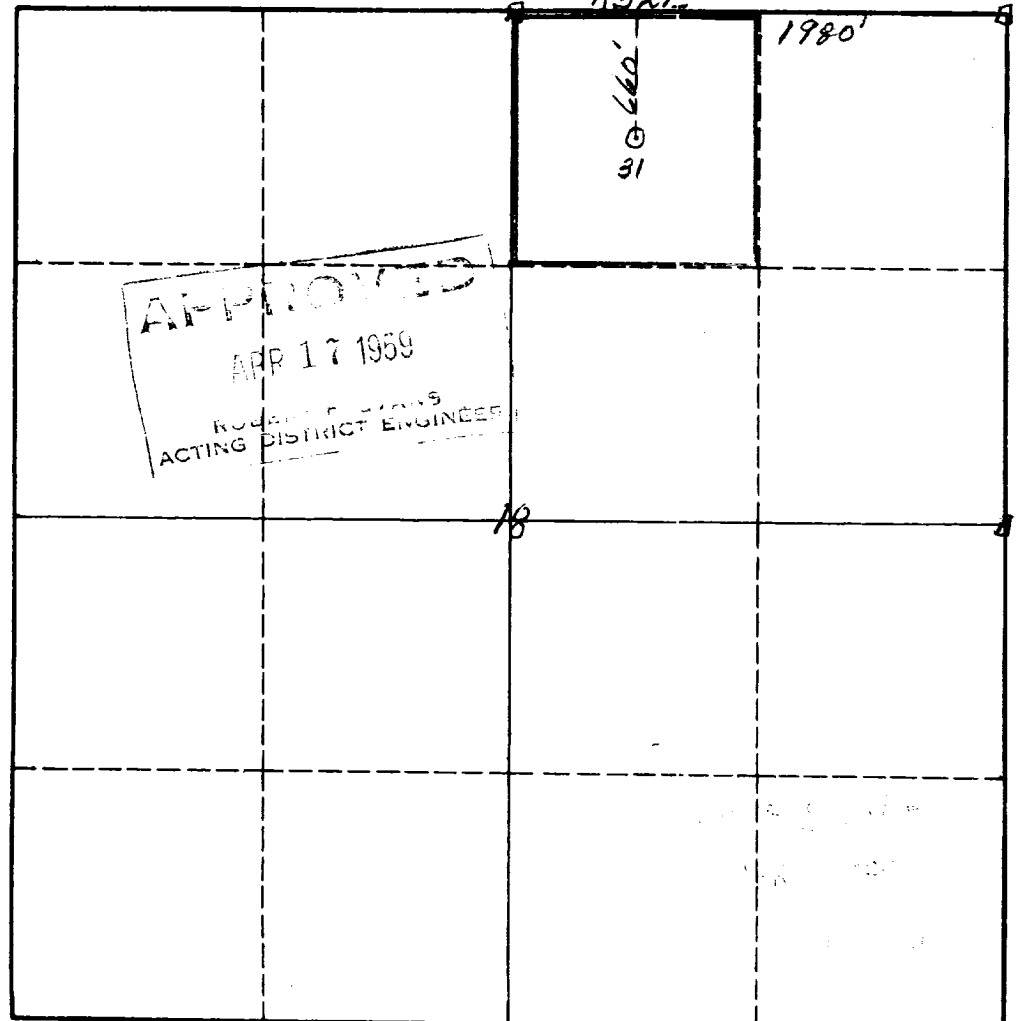
