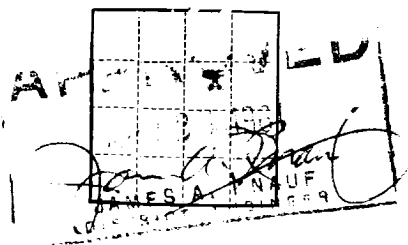

DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to a TD of approximately 5362', utilizing the well bore of the plugged & abandoned Wm. Mitchell A No. 19. All Csg.Pts. have been or will be Cmtd. in accordance with approved methods of the USGS and any other special requirements will be complied with. Csg. Pattern: 13 3/8" OD 36# Armco csg. is set at 86' and Cmtd with 75 Sx, Cired. 2473'-8 5/8" OD 24, 28 & 32# Csg is set at 2490' and Cmtd with 300 Sx in 2 stages. It is proposed to CO and ream 7 3/4" hole to TD. 4 1/2" OD 9.50# Csg will be set at approximately 5362' and Cmtd. with 350 Sx. It is calculated the Cmt behind the 4 1/2" Csg. will return to 2500'. Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

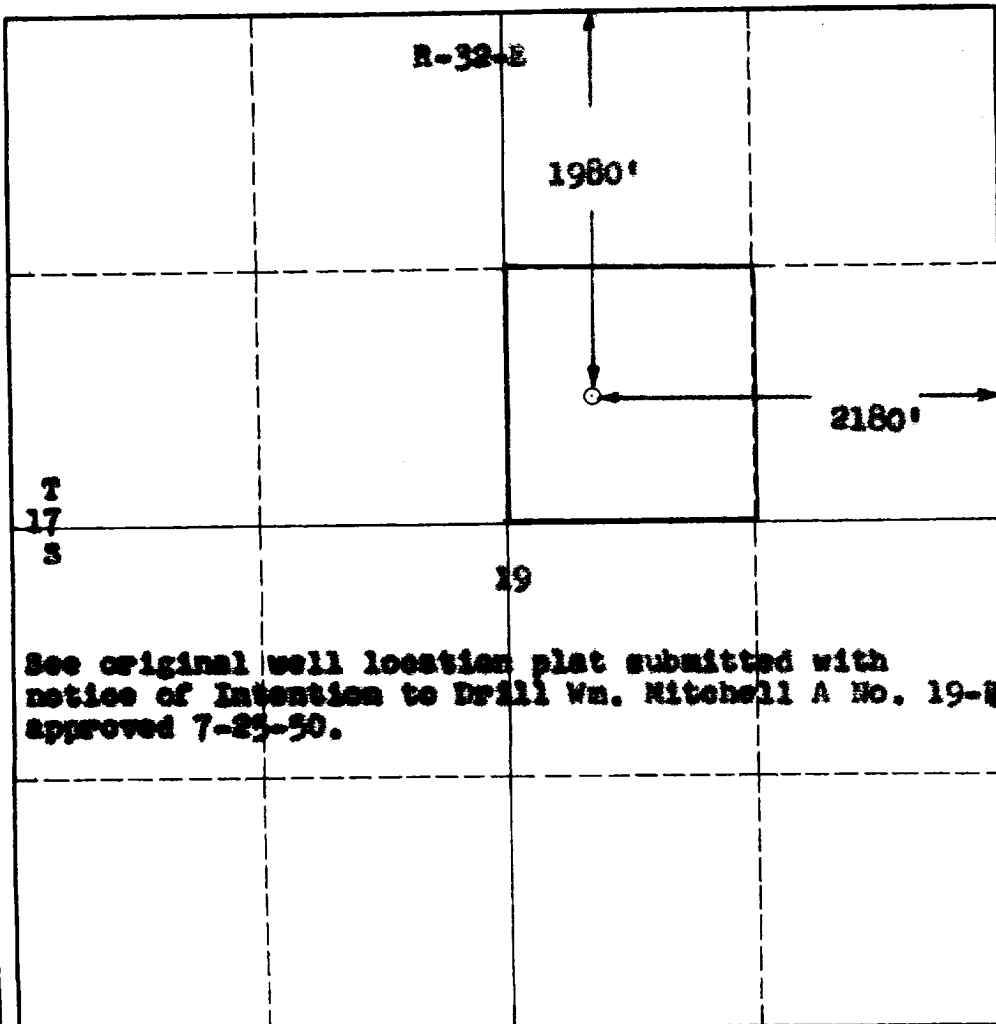
