

DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with procedure approved by Nr. Frost by phone on August 25, 1950, this well has been temporarily abandoned. The work was performed as follows: 25 sacks of coment were spotted from 5359 to 5284' through drill pipe. Pipe was then raised and 185 sacks were spotted from \$150 to 3600'. Pipe was then raised and 10 sacks were spotted in 8-5/8" casing from 2470 to 2438'. A swage and valve has been placed in top of casing.
