## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Using the Chemical Process Company, treated through casing perforations 10,370 to 10,450 feet with 1000 gallons Formjel followed by 8000 gallons 15% low tension acid. Injection pressures: Maximum 3800 psi, minimum and final 1900 psi. Total load 531 barrels. Kicked off with swab. Flowed 524 barrels fluid in 17½ hours through various chokes. Then flowed 246.3 barrels oil and 427 MCF of gas in 24 hours through 15/64-inch choke. Flowing casing pressure 250 psi. Flowing tubing pressure 875 psi. Gas-Oil ratio 1733:1
