DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

1. Ran 5 1/2" N-80 casing and landed same at 11,543'; cemented with 500 sx. neat slo-set cement. Top of cement at 9620' by temperature survey.
2. Tested casing with 1000 psi hydraulic pressure for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure.
3. Cleaned out to float shoe and perforated casing from 11,410 to 11,440' with 2 bullets and 2 jets per/ft.
