The following is report of State of New Mexico "Q" Well
No. 1, Lea County:

This well, located 1980 feet from North and 660 feet from East lines
of Section 35, 15-S, 37-E, So. Denton Devonian Field, was spudded
July 12, 1956.

Drilled to 370 feet, ran 10 joints (349.47') of 13-3/8" 48#, H-40
casing and set @ 365 feet with 375 sacks of regular Neat cement,
circulated.

Drilled to 5025 feet, ran 169 jts. (5014.25') of 9-5/8" 40# N-80
and 36# J-55 casing and set @ 5024 feet with 4000 sacks Pozmix
and 200 sacks reg. Neat cement. Plug down at 4:00 P.M. July 23,
1956, guide shoe and float collar on bottom joint, circ. cement.
Ran temperature survey and found top of cement at 715'.

Today's depth 8582 feet, sandy lime, drilling.
