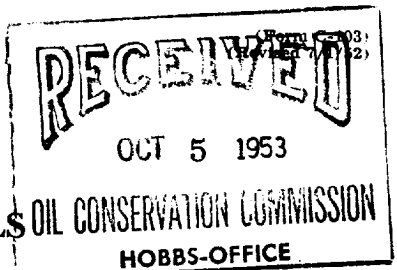

Pumped plug to 285' @ 8 PM, 9/30/53. Max. pressure, 250#.
Cement circulated. After WOC for 12 hours, drilled cement
from 285' to 305'. Tested 13-3/8" casing W/500# before & after
drilling cement - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation
and 12-1/4" hole from 305' at 8:30 PM, 10/1/53 -
