DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 17-1/2 inch hole to 334 feet in red beds. Ran 315 feet (10 joints) 13-3/8 inch OD, 48-lb., H-40, SS, ST&C, new National casing with Texas Pattern shoe. Cemented casing at 330 feet with 350 sacks (175 sacks neat cement plus 175 sacks Halliburton Pozmix plus 2% bentonite). Cement circulated. Plug down 8:00 AM, July 25, 1954. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 500 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and drilled 11-inch hole ahead.
