## DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to clean out subject well to 4198 feet and treat open hole from 3797 to 4198 feet with 15,000 gallons Sandfrac with 1# sand per gallon. Treatment to be through 2 1/2-inch tubing with packer set in 7-inch casing at approximately 3750 feet.
