March 23, we ran 3698' of 7" O.D. 20# New Sals. casing and cemented with 300 sac by Halliburton. Mud proceeded the cement and was circulated to surface. After allowing the cement to set 72 hours, plug was drilled and water was swabbed out and drilling resumed.
