DETAILS OF WORK

On July 12, 1949, this well was shot from 3614' - 3685' using 3-1/2" shells and 120 quarts of nitro-glycerine. A 100' gravel tamp was used and hole loaded with oil. Well was cleaned out to total depth of 3960'. Cleaning out finished and tubing run July 17.
