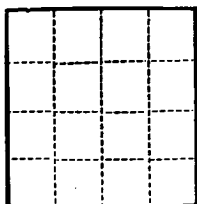

DETAILS OF WORK

This well will be drilled with cable tools for an input well to return gas to the producing formation, and will not be used as a producing well.

8-5/8" OD casing will be set in the anhydrite lying immediately above the salt at an estimated depth of 900' and will be cemented with 50 sacks of cement preceded by 10-sacks of aquagel. The 7" casing will be set in lime immediately above the 6th zone at an estimated depth of 3770', and will be cemented with 150 sacks of cement preceded by 15 sacks of aquagel. The well will then be drilled to a depth sufficient to penetrate the 9th zone, which total depth is estimated at 4130 ft.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
