DETAILS OF WORK

This well will be drilled with cable tools and will be used as an input well for returning gas to the producing formations and will not be used as a producing well.

We will set approximately 800 feet of 8-5/8-inch OD casing the Anhydrite immediately overlying the salt section and will cement it with 50 sacks of cement preceded by tin sacks of aquagel. We will set approximately 3700 feet of 7 inch OD casing in the Line immediately above the 6th zone and will cement it with 150 sacks of cement preceded by 15 sacks of aquagel. We will then drill the well to the ninth zone at an estimated depth of 4200 feet.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
